21. Baby Jumper and Teenage Jumper - 2' & 2'6 Open juniors, amateurs and professionals on horses and ponies.

22. GHJA Juniors Equitation Challenge - Open to all junior and adult amateur GHJA members on horses or ponies. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter: USEF test 9 (rides without stirrups) and 17 (counter canter) will be required of all riders. Martin-gales not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who won the Final Junior Eq. Challenge in 2006 and 2007 are no longer eligible to compete in this class. The top 20 riders who have accumulated points throughout the year will qualify to ride in the Final Phase of the Challenge at the GHJA Finals Horse Show.

FROM THE SOUTH From I-285, take I-75 North to I-575 North. Exit Town Lake (Exit #8). Turn right off the exit. Go 2.5 miles to Falcon Ridge Stables (on the left) at 347 Arnold mill road. Just past Woodstock Presbyterian Church and just before Little River North & South subdivisions.

FROM ALPHARETTA From north GA-400, take Hwy 92 west about 15 miles (Hwy 92 changes names several times (Crossville Rd/Old Alabama/Holcomb Bridge/Crabapple) stay straight. Make right onto Trickum Road (Publix is on the right and Kroger is catty-corner on left). Take Trickum Road to Arnold Mill Road. Make a left (BP station on left) and go 1.5 miles. Falcon Ridge Stables will be on the right.

Class specifications and Divisions

1. Short Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. **NOTE:** *Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". A rider may cross enter only into either Schooling Pony or Junior/Senior Hunter (2'6" only) at the same show, and may also enter age group equitation (not to include GHJA Equitation or any "medal" type classes) and non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years. If a rider is 12 years old their first year of showing in Short Stirrup, he/she may show in Long Stirrup classes as a 13-year-old; this will constitute that rider's 2nd consecutive year. Year will begin December 1st and end November 30th. Fence Height 2'*

2. Short Stirrup Equitation - open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'.

3. Schooling Pony - 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainers discretion. Open to Junior riders only.

*Pony ring will be set for 12' Pony Stride

4. Small Pony Hunter - 2' (ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh)

5. Med Pony Hunter - 2'3" (ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh)

6. Large Pony Hunter - 2'9" (ponies over 13.2 hh, but not to exceed 14.2 hh)

7. Long Stirrup Hunter - Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years of age and older, on horses or ponies. Riders cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past 5 years. Rider may only compete in this division no more for 2 consecutive years. May cross enter only into classes in which fences do not exceed 2'6", not to include GHJA Equitation or any "medal" type classes. If a rider was 12 years old their first year of showing in Short Stirrup, he/she may show in Long Stirrup classes only as a 13-year-old; this will constitute that rider's 2nd consecutive year. Year begins Dec. 1st and ends Nov. 30th. Fence height 2'3".

8. Long Stirrup Equitation - Open to qualified Long Stirrup Riders. Fence height 2'3".

9. Junior/Senior Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination can have never shown over fences 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show. Fence height 2'6".

10. Open Hunter - 2'6" or 3' (horse or pony). Rider may show in either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

11. Adult Amateur Hunter - 3'. Open to all horses ridden by an Amateur.

12. Children's Hunter - 3'. Open to all horses ridden by a Junior.

13. Green Working Hunter - 3' and 3'3". Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 3' and higher at any horse show recognized by the USEF or one of its affiliates.

14. JD Pounds and Adult Equitation - JD Pounds is open to all juniors on horses and Adult Equitation is open to amateurs, eighteen and over on horses, who are current members of the GHJA. Will be shown at 3' over a modified-jumper type course of at least eight fences. There will be at least one over and one change of direction. A minimum of six riders, if available will be called back for a flat phase which counts as 25%. The judge may ask riders to perform USEF test 1-19. Three horses must complete both phases in order for points to count toward end of the year.

15. Equitation 11 and under - 2',

16. Equitation 12 to 14 - 2'6" No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

17. Equitation 15 to 17 - 3'

18. Adult Amateur Equitation - 3'

19. Low Schooling Jumper - under 3'6"

20. High Schooling Jumper - 3'6" and higher

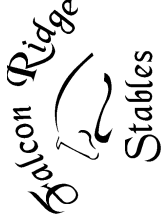
