FROM THE SOUTH From I-285, take I-75 North to I-575 North. Exit Town Lake (Exit #8). Turn right off the exit. Go 2.5 miles to Falcon Ridge Stables (on the left) at 347 Arnold mill road. Just past Woodstock Presbyterian Church and just before Little River North & South subdivisions.

FROM ALPHARETTA From north GA-400, take Hwy 92 west about 15 miles (Hwy 92 changes names several times (Crossville Rd/Old Alabama/Holcomb Bridge/Crabapple) stay straight. Make right onto Trickum Road (Publix is on the right and Kroger is catty-corner on left). Take Trickum Road to Arnold Mill Road. Make a left (BP station on left) and go 1.5 miles. Falcon Ridge Stables will be on the right.

12. Adult Amateur Hunter - 3'. Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter divisions or Junior Equitation division or Junior Medal at the same show.

13. Children's Hunter - 3'. Open to all horses ridden by a Junior.

14. Green Working Hunter - 3' and 3'3". Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 3' and higher at any horse show recognized by the USEF or one of its affiliates.

15. Equitation 11 and under - 2' No straight lines may be set at less than 60'

16. Equitation 12 to 14 - 2'6" No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

17. Equitation 15 to 17 - 3'

18. Adult Amateur Equitation - 3'

19. J.D. Pounds Medal for Juniors on Horses and GHJA Medal for Adult Amateur Riders: To be shown over a modified jumper-type course of at least eight fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. Height of fences shall be 3'. A minimum of six riders, if available, will be required to show at a walk, trot and canter. The under saddle performance of the selected riders shall count 25%. Three entries must complete both phases for qualification points to count

20. Low Schooling Jumper - under 3' & 3'3"

21. High Schooling Jumper - 3'6" & 3'9"

22. GHJA Junior's Equitation Challenge – Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur GHJA members on horses or ponies. To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter. **Competitors will be asked to perform at least two of the following USEF tests chosen by the Judge: #1-Halt; #2-Hand gallop; #9-Ride without stirrups; #15-Change leads on a line demonstrating a simple or flying change of lead; #17- Canter on the counter lead.** Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who have won the Final Junior's Equitation Challenge in 2006, 2007, or 2008 are no longer eligible to compete in this class. November 1st is the cut off date for riding in qualifying classes at shows. Participation in the Junior Equitation Finals is limited to current junior and adult amateur members of the GHJA. The top 20 riders who have accumulated points throughout the year will qualify to ride in the Final Phase of the Challenge at the GHJA Finals Horse Show. **In the Final Phase** riders will be asked to perform any two or more of the USEF tests 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17 & 18. The judge will then require the top 4 riders to switch horses (USEF test #16) and perform any two or more tests that were previously ridden. This class is a fund raiser for the GHJA Juniors Committee and \$10.00 of each entry fee is given to the Juniors for their community projects. In the past they have purchased and donated an Equine Rescue Sling to the city of Milton and donated money to the Animal SOS Fund.

23. Junior/Amateur Hunter: 3'3". Open to all horses ridden by a Junior or an Amateur.

Unrecognized Classes:

Blue/Red Warm-up: is open during all hunter and equitation classes, multiple rounds are permitted.

Baby and Teenage Jumpers: open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2' and 2'6".

FRS Hunter & Equitation—is open to all beginner riders, fences 18"-2' - simple changes will not be penalized

Crossrails Mini Course Hunter & Equitation—open to all beginner riders, will consist of a course of 6-8 crossrails set at 18". Simple changes will not be penalized.

Crossrail Once Around Twice Around—open all beginner riders, set at 18". Riders can not cross enter into classes 95-99. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Class specifications and Division

1. Short Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. **NOTE:** *Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and cross rail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18".* A rider on a pony may cross-enter only into Schooling Pony (2' only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. A rider on a horse may cross enter only into Junior/Senior Hunter (2'6" only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2' for ponies and 2'6" for horses. Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years. The two years of Short Stirrup eligibility are continuous show calendar years and can not be separated or divided in any manner. If a rider ages out of short stirrup after one year of eligibility, the rider may compete in Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation divisions for the next consecutive show year, concluding the continuous two years of eligibility for these two divisions. Short and Long stirrup eligibility are to be counted together: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup Divisions for a total of two consecutive show years. The year will begin December 1st and end November 30th. Fence height 2".
2. Short Stirrup Equitation - open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'.
3. Schooling Pony - 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainers discretion. Open to Junior riders only.
4. Small Pony Hunter - 2' Open to junior riders 12 years and younger, ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh.
5. Med Pony Hunter - 2'3" Open to junior riders 14 years and younger, ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh).
6. Large Pony Hunter - 2'9" Open to all junior riders (ponies over 13.2 hh, but not to exceed 14.2 hh)
7. GHJA Pony medal - To be shown over a modified jumper-type course of at least eight fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. Height of fences shall be 2' for small ponies, 2'3" for medium ponies and 2'9" for large ponies. The GHJA Pony Medal may be run concurrently with the Pony Hunter divisions and the flat phase then held immediately following the pony hunter under saddle classes. The under saddle performance of a minimum of six riders, if available, shall count 25% Alternatively, the GHJA Pony Medal may be run concurrently with the Pony Hunter divisions and in lieu of a flat phase, two tests from USEF Tests 1 – 9 (see Appendix B) must be included in the over fences performance. Three entries must complete the over fences and testing requirements for qualification points to count.
8. Long Stirrup Hunter - Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years of age and older, on horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. Note: Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and cross rail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders who are re-entering the show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past 5 years. Riders may compete in this division no more than 2 consecutive years. The two years of eligibility are continuous show calendar years that cannot be separated or divided in any manner. A rider may cross enter only into Hunter divisions and age group equitation at the same show if fence height does not exceed 2'6", not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. If a rider ages out of Short Stirrup after one year of eligibility, the rider may compete in Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation divisions for the next consecutive show year, concluding the continuous two years of eligibility for these divisions. Short and Long stirrup eligibility are to be counted together: a rider may compete in short and /or Long Stirrup Divisions for a total of two consecutive show years. Year begins December 1st and ends November 30th. Fence height 2'3".
9. Long Stirrup Equitation – Open to qualified Long Stirrup Riders. Fence height 2'3".
10. Junior/Senior Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination can have never shown over fences 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show. Fence height 2'6".
11. Open Hunter - 2'6" or 3' (horse or pony). Rider may show in either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.
